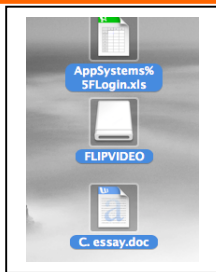


# Instructions for uploading a Flip Video: for Macs



Insert the flip video into the USB port on your laptop.  
Allow the program to load.

When it is loaded up click on the FLIPVIDEO device on your desktop  
Once it opens the Flip Video will show this screen

Click on the **Flip Video for Mac** and it will start the application and once loaded it will look like this.

To move around use the multi colored navigation menu on the lower left.

**First, save the video that you created to the computer, then you can share the videos as they are or make a movie.**

## Making a Movie Mix

A Movie Mix will take your video add a background and music of your choosing or a sample that goes with the theme chosen.

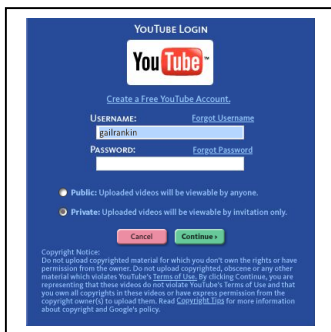
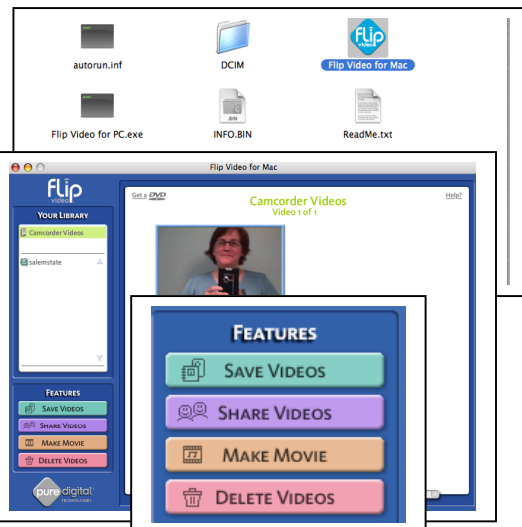
## Sharing Videos

To share the videos:

1. click on the video
2. click on Share Videos Button.

If you find that you are not ready to do this, then click on the Back button at the bottom of the screen

On the next screen you need to click on the video to be shared and then click on the **Continue** button next to YouTube.



You will need a YouTube account. If you don't have it then get a free one by clicking on the link under the logo.

**Make sure you choose to upload your video as private so you can control who sees it.**

Login and the upload will begin.

**Allow time. It will take ten minutes for every 20 mb of video.**

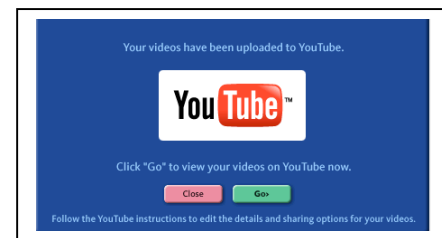
Once complete you will get the following screen

You can edit your video or delete it.

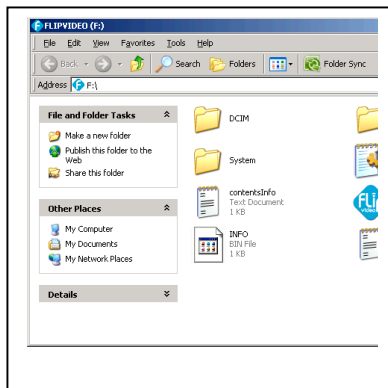
If it is private you will need to go to the Contacts and Subscribers section and invite other users.

**To make the URL a live link in a Blackboard discussion, make sure you enable the html creator and then click on the chain link to add the link.**



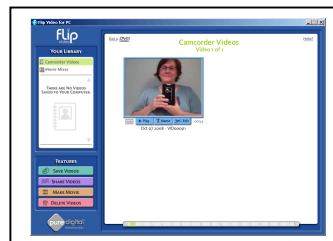
# Instructions for uploading a video on a PC



Insert the flip video into the USB port on your laptop. Allow the program to load.

It will open to a menu where you can choose to look at files and folder or to this option on the left. Click on the **Flip Video for PC**. If you don't have the program installed it will install the programs on your computer.

Once the Flip Video for PC is loaded, users will see this main display. The



loaded, users main area will

display the videos, and the colored legend in the bottom corner will step you through the process.

To move around use the multi colored navigation menu on the lower left.

A Movie Mix will take your video add a background and music of your choosing or a sample that goes with the theme chosen.

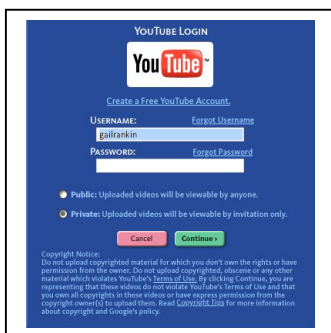
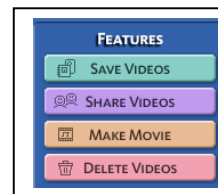
## Sharing Videos
